Code of Honor

Violations of the Honor Code are acts of academic dishonesty and include, but are not limited to, plagiarism, copying, aiding academic dishonesty, lying to peers, faculty, or institute staff, gaining unauthorized access to protected academic information, inappropriate personal or professional conduct, or any attempt to commit any of the violations mentioned.

Honor Code Violations:

1. Plagiarism is the depiction or reproduction of someone else's work or idea like yours.
2. Copying is giving or receiving unauthorized aid, the use of forbidden notes, assignments, or study aids. Allowing someone else to do your work or exam.
3. Assisting or serving as an accomplice in academic dishonesty such as intentionally facilitating any act that violates the honor code.
4. Threat is an attempt to intimidate a student, staff, or faculty member in order to receive an unearned grade or in an effort to avoid reporting a violation of the Honor Code.
5. Unauthorized access to protected academic information including but not limited to staff or faculty, archives, and/or administrative office.
